

St. Joseph County Public Library Upgrades AMH for New, Cutting-edge Library

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EnvisionWare® Modular Sorter™ Construction of the new library was completed in November 2021. The project consisted of a complete renovation of the Main Library building, including a new dedicated teen area and larger children's area, quiet spaces and more study room, new public computer and digital lab space, an updated local and family history space, construction of a new Community Learning Center and auditorium, and the creation of a courtyard and greenspace.

With high circulation numbers, the sorters get a lot of use. In addition to the downtown location, the Library has nine branches. Five of the locations have sorters to expedite getting materials back on the shelves of these busy locations.
